

The Festival of Lights once again illuminates the newly renovated Gendarmenmarkt - with the Konzerthaus Berlin shining as its radiant prologue. The focus was on the art project 'Die Hände Berlins' (The Hands of Berlin): children from the Arche Kinderstiftung, together with children from Berlin primary schools, made a statement of solidarity with colourful handprints and submitted drawings. 



It's a Berlin landmark that mixes history with modernity and represents the city around the world. At this year's Festival of Lights, the column was lit up in a spectacular 360-degree video mapping show that really made it pop. The video art show presented on the Victory Column covered transformation in all its facets. 

In the pulsating heart of Berlin, a fascinating dialogue between artistic expression and communal experience emerged. As part of the Bebelplatz Light Orchestra, the Staatsoper
